Pilotage is the skill of inshore navigation, where visual references are often available

...shoals and shallows



...shipping channels





...chain ferries

## Pilotage


### Remember to consider how different an expanse of water can look between high and low water








#### Flashing red lights...



...serious emergency do not proceed




#### Red lights...



...do not proceed (waiting for lock)




#### **Green lights...**



...proceed one way traffic



Two green lights over a white...



...proceed two way traffic



**Green - white - green lights...** 




...await orders to proceed



### Clearing Bearings & Contours

The skipper of the motorboat wants to be sure of avoiding the rock (0.9 drying) off False Cape before turning towards the anchorage





To navigate safely in congested inshore waters it's best to spend as much time as possible on deck



This means you are able to...

...keep an eye out for other vessels

...make sure your vessel stays on the required ground track, using visual references


#### Information you need....



- ...tidal streams and heights
- ...distance and journey time
- ...hazards on route
- ...available aids to pilotage
- ...VHF channels
- ...port regulations



Making a sketch can enable you to extract essential details of your plan to keep handy on deck
