





Common Causes of Fire




















Petrol vapours



Always vent the engine space before starting an inboard petrol engine

Keep outboards on deck to avoid the build up of vapour below









Dry powder – don't use on flammable liquids





CO2 / Halocarbon – good for enclosed spaces, such as the engine compartment






AFFF – foam, good for flammable liquids





Blanket – good for smothering flames









Gas safety
